Linen Freshener	<p>Spray linen and cupboards for a fresh, herbal fragrance. Especially effective in coastal areas where the smell of mildew is prevalent. Many people, such as asthma and Hay Fever sufferers are allergic to mildew.</p> <p>An effective method for re-freshening linen or clothing is to spray laundry while it is spin drying. For a fresh, clean environment, spray the pillow slips before the guests arrive.</p>
Room & Upholstery Spray	<p>Can be used in any room in the house. For couches, mattresses or curtains spray lightly.</p>
Fragrance	<p>A clean, fresh fragrance which includes a bouquet of herbs.</p>
Anti-bacterial	<p>Outstanding antimicrobial activity against Gram-positive and Gram-negative bacteria, molds and yeasts.</p>
Safety & First Aid	<p>It is safe to use around people or animals and also safe for the environment. Avoid spraying into the face and eyes. Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, drink water, do not induce vomiting.</p>

Ingredients	<p>Aqua (Demineralised Water), Rectified Spirits, Polysorbate 20, Peg 12 Dimethicone, Citronella Oil, Perfum, Biocides.</p>
Directions for use	<p>HomCare Linen Spray is ready to use and should not to be diluted with water or combined with other chemicals. The product should be dispensed with an atomiser and can be sprayed directly onto linen, fabrics and surfaces.</p>
